



Storm Drain Maintenance Contractor Application

Clean Water Services and its member Cities are compiling a list of contractors that agree to perform maintenance according to the criteria adopted by Clean Water Services to help ensure the proper maintenance and function of private storm drain systems. Private storm drain systems typically include catch basins, water quality manholes, and inlet and outlet structures. The list will be a resource for owners and managers of commercial and industrial businesses, apartment complexes, etc. in Washington County and parts of Clackamas and Multnomah Counties.

To apply, a Contractor must:

1. Provide two references of work performed on storm drain systems within Clean Water Services' jurisdiction.
2. Be licensed to perform work in the State of Oregon.
3. Inform Clean Water Services or the City of the dump site and disposal method for materials removed.
4. Follow preferred maintenance practices as specified in the District's Private Water Quality Facility Management Program (PWQFMP) Inspection Guide.
5. Complete the application form and submit required information. Items 4 and 5 are available at cleanwaterservices.org

Contractors accepted for the list must comply with the practices set forth in the PWQFMP Inspection Guide. Failure to comply will result in removal from the list for six months, after which the Contractor may re-apply.
